Priority Species History

Scarce Blue-tailed Damselfly – discovered in 1995, when C (6-20) reported; the same seen on 27/7/98, including a pair *in cop.*; a systematic search on 11/7/99 produced at least 95, including 10 *in cop.*, 1 egg-laying and 3 emergents; However, only 5 found on 16/7/05, 6 on 15/7/06 and a fairly thorough search on 29/7/24 produced none.

Habitat

Open moorland with M29 runnels, flushes and *Molinia* mires on the east-facing slopes down to Walla Brook between 320 and 350 m ASL. *Molinia* abundant, with areas of *Sphagnum* and cotton-grass; *Eleocharis*, Bog Pondweed and Marsh St John's-wort frequent in runnels.
