### **Key Species History**

**Scarce Blue-tailed Damselfly** – discovered around SX537649 in 1995, when C (6-20) recorded; C also in 6/98 and 6 (2 pairs *in cop.*) on 11/7/24; in 2010 and 2018, also recorded about 800 m to the north at SX53806562, with C in both years and 1 egg-laying 11/7/10. (See SRD below.)

[**Small Red Damselfly** – C (including mating pair(s)) on 13/7/06, but accredited to Kath Allen, who was marking Scarce Blue-tailed Damselflies then; likely to be input error and actually refer to that species.]

Open moorland with acidic grassland, bracken and runnels and stream.

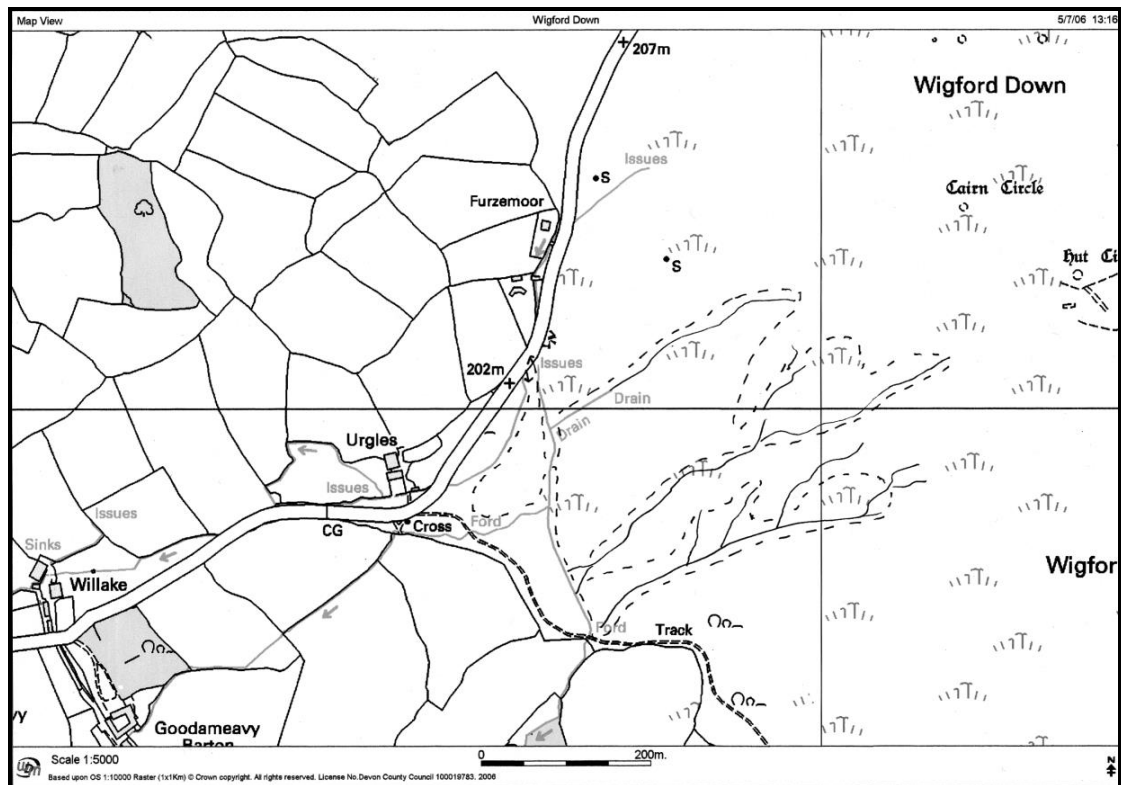
**Local Authority:** Dartmoor NP/West Devon
